REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH SERVICES

Policy:

Mid Valley Hospital and Clinic (MVH) recognizes an individual's fundamental right to make informed decisions regarding their reproductive health. MVH provides a range of outpatient and inpatient reproductive health benefits, services, or information to meet the reproductive needs and choices of individuals in our community.

To ensure the safety of our patients, reproductive health services and/or procedures that are deemed by a provider to be more appropriately and safely performed at another facility by a qualified provider will be promptly referred. Mid Valley Hospital does not mandate that its healthcare professionals perform or participate in procedures that are in violation of their conscience, beliefs, or values.
